Leopards are night animals. This mean they prefer to sleep during the day and move around all night. They have amazing eyesight and can see much better in the dark than humans. While most leopards have light fur with dark spots, there is a different type called the black leopard. It has dark fur with dark spots. 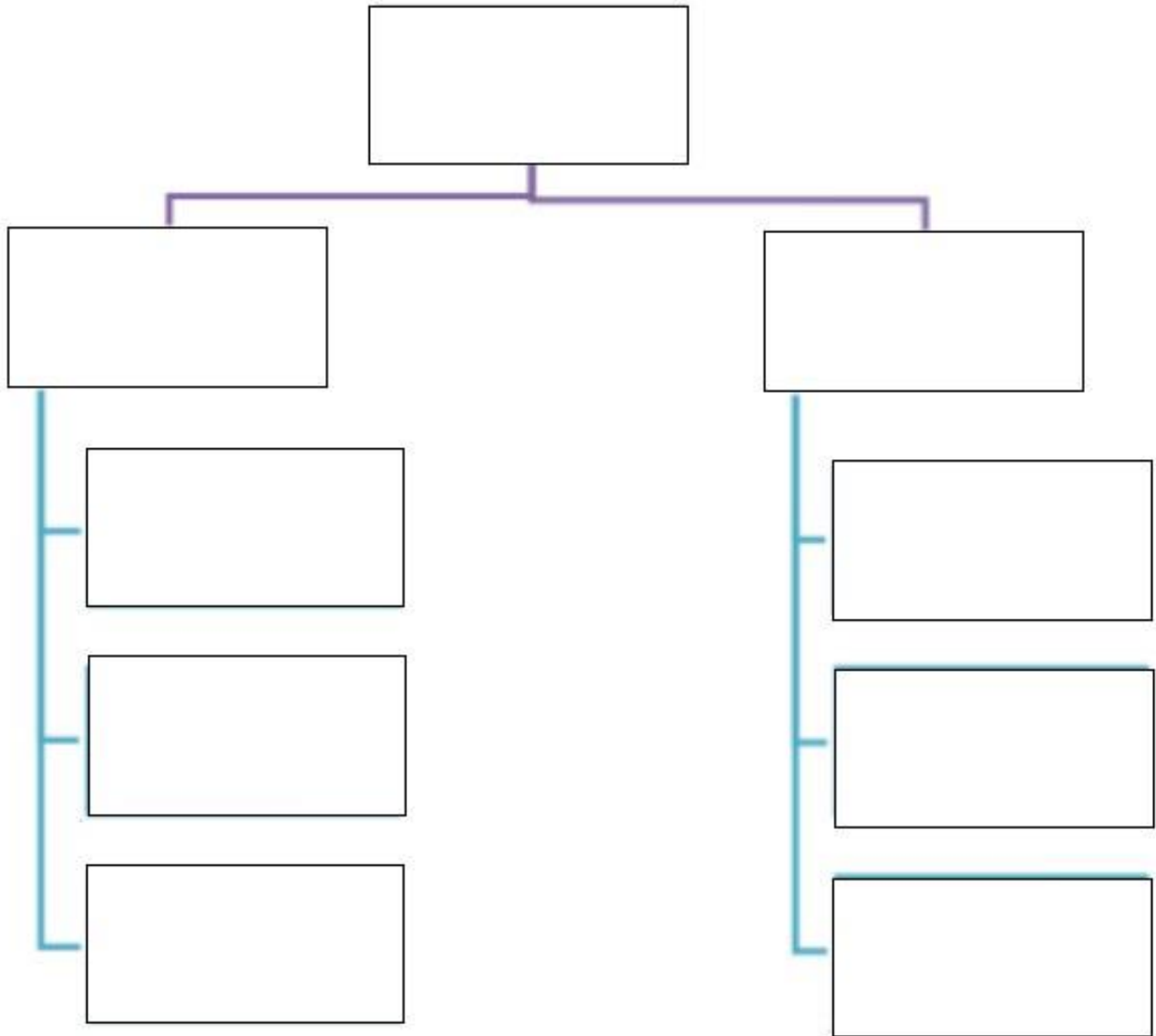

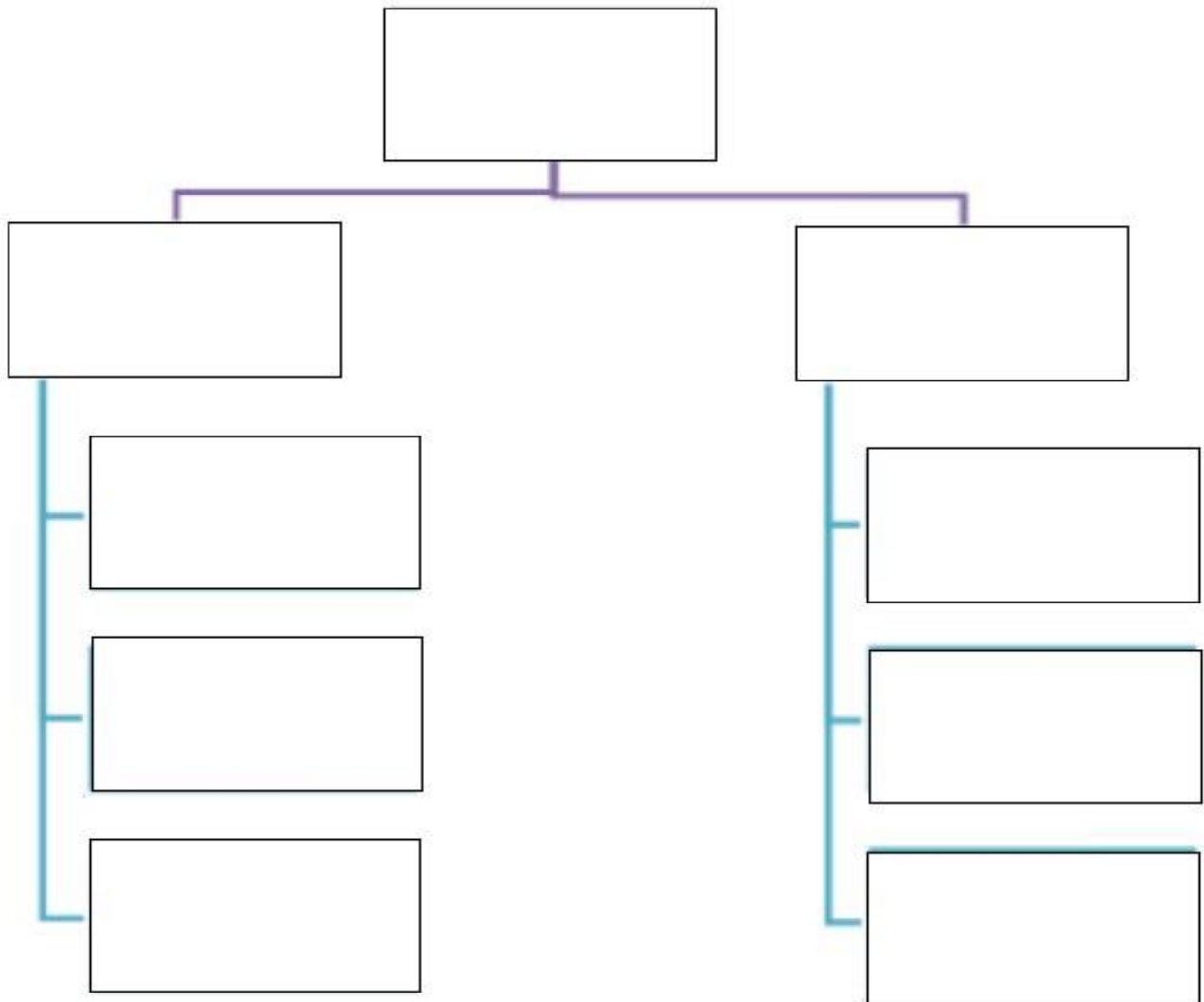
